Technology Code of Conduct**

A good computer user:

1. Uses the computer for school work and in a manner consistent with teacher instructions.
2. Does not use the computer to hurt people's feelings or their work.
3. Respects the computer as school property, and does not damage the computer or computing systems (printers, etc.).
4. Reports broken equipment or problems with equipment to a teacher.
5. Does not use the computer to look at, send or print messages or pictures in violation of District policies, such as messages/images meant to bully, threaten or harass another person.
6. Respects the environment; does not waste paper or ink by printing too much.
7. Respects the rights of others; does not go into another person's folders, work, or files without permission.
8. Acts responsibly; immediately tells an adult if his or her computer displays inappropriate material.
9. Does not use the school computer to disclose personal information, such as full name, home address, telephone number, school address, or parents/guardians' names on the Internet.
10. Respects the law; does NOT violate copyright laws.
11. Accepts responsibility for proper computer use. Always follows teacher's directions; knows misuse of the computer system can result in loss of computer privilege or other disciplinary action.
